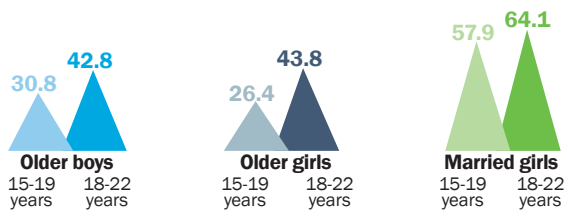
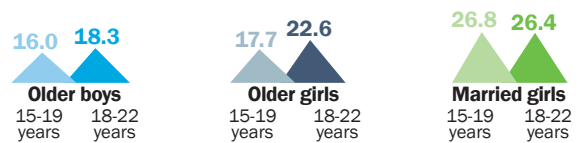


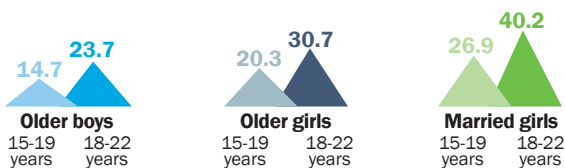
Aware of at least one pregnancy- and sex related matter* (%)



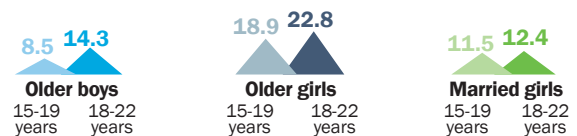
Heard about Sexually Transmitted Infections other than HIV/AIDS (%)



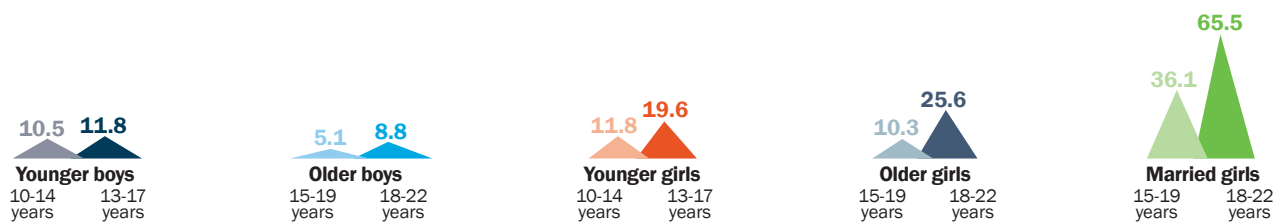
Aware of at least 3 of the maternal and newborn care practices# (%)



Ever received family life or sex education (%)



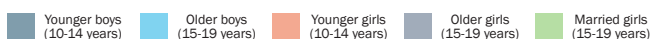
Interacted with any of the frontline workers (Anganwadi workers and ASHAs) in the last one year (%)
